CareSouth Carolina Offering Johnson & Johnson Vaccine at its Mobile & Pop-up Events

At this time, CareSouth Carolina will be offering the Johnson & Johnson vaccine at all of its mobile and pop-up site events.

An up-to-date schedule for the mobile and pop-up site events can be found at caresouth-carolina.com/calendar.

The Moby, which is a mobile unit equipped with healthcare technology, allows CareSouth Carolina providers, nurses and community health workers to operate outside of the four walls of their office locations and help treat and care for patients in their own communities.

"CareSouth Carolina is taking mobile units into the rural communities to make sure anyone that desires to have a vaccine will have access to a vaccine," CareSouth Carolina Chief of Nursing Tracie Thigpen said. "The vaccines are proven to be 95% effective against COVID 19. The more individuals who are vaccinated, the closer society will be to returning to normal."

No appointment is necessary as all events are first-come, first-serve. Vaccines will be given out to anyone ages 18 and older and you do not have to be a patient of CareSouth Carolina to receive a vaccine.

The CDC and the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) recommended use of Johnson & Johnson's Janssen (J&J/Janssen) COVID-19 Vaccine resume in the United States, after a temporary pause. A review of all available data at this time shows that the J&J/Janssen COVID-19 Vaccine's known and potential benefits outweigh its known and potential risks for those recommended to receive it. The pause allowed CDC to communicate with healthcare providers and re-emphasize the importance of reporting severe events in people who have received this vaccine, as well as how to report such events. The pause also gave experts time to carefully review all available data and conduct a risk-benefit analysis around the use of this vaccine.
