CareSouth Carolina launches its first Community Garden in Society Hill



CareSouth Carolina representatives gathered on Wednesday, August 31, with Society Hill residents to kick-off the healthcare center's first community garden. The garden site is located behind St. David Academy on Main Street, in Society Hill, near the town's ballpark.

"We're very excited about this project," said Christy Beasley, CareSouth Carolina Community Health Educator, who is leading this opportunity.

"We have everything in place there at the site needed for a successful garden: soil, shovels, the raised bed frames, weed barriers."

We are planting a fall garden that will include lettuces, carrots, beets, onions and broccoli," Beasley said. "And everything will be grown from seeds," adding that, "a pack of seeds really goes a long way," something most people take for granted. Another thing people tend to take for granted, especially younger people, according to Beasley, is just where the food they eat comes from.

CareSouth Carolina welcomes Internal Medicine Physician Catherine Compton, D.O. to its Bishopville Center, located at 545 Sumter Highway in Bishopville, S.C. Dr. Compton, who is originally from Kansas, attended Edward Via College in Spartanburg, S.C., where she earned her degree in Osteopathic Medicine.

Compton says she knew “at age 11” exactly what she wanted to do in terms of her career and was willing to put in the extra time it takes to become a D.O. “I ultimately chose D.O. over M.D. because they tend to focus more on the whole body and more holistic elements of medicine and we receive an additional 200 hours of training in osteopathic medical manipulation,” she said. “So really an understanding of the bones, and the fascia, and the tissue and how it works together.”

Compton treats a wide variety of medical issues and says she looks forward to educating patients in Bishopville. “Things that really affect rural populations – diabetes, hypertension – those are things that can really be adjusted by diet and lifestyle. I really like to treat diabetes, hypertension, acne, rosacea and migraines,” she said. “Education is a huge issue. Diet, exercise and what those things mean. For example, a lot of patients think they’re being healthy by eating a salad – but then they add a lot of cheese, ham, the dressing. So at the end of the day there’s no nutritional value to what they’re eating,” she explained.

In her free time, Compton enjoys baking, gardening, painting watercolors and taking long walks outside with her two dogs - Gryffin, a Golden Retriever, and Puff, a Great Pyrenees.
