

Free Vaccination: Thanks to a grant secured by CareSouth Carolina, the Fall COVID Booster Vaccine is currently offered to patients free of charge.

Pfizer Vaccine: Patients receiving booster shots can rest assure that they will be administered the Pfizer vaccine, a trusted vaccine authorized for booster doses.

Flexible Access: Patients have the option to either walk in for their booster shot or schedule an appointment, providing flexibility and convenience for everyone.

Pediatric and Adult Vaccination: Pediatric patients need to make appointments at the pediatric offices, while adult patients can receive their booster at other CareSouth Carolina offices.

Eligibility: Patients must wait at least two months since their last COVID-19 vaccination before receiving the booster shot. Individuals who have never received a COVID-19 shot can initiate their vaccination with this booster, which requires only one shot.

Open Enrollment for health coverage in the upcoming plan year has officially begun and will run from November 1 through January 15, 2024.

The coverage obtained during this period can kick in as early as January 1, allowing people to start the new year with the protection they need. This annual Open Enrollment Period is a critical window for those seeking health insurance coverage through the Affordable Care Act, providing a chance to secure quality healthcare that aligns with their financial resources and health requirements.

Certified by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), CareSouth Carolina staff are available and offer free assistance in educating the community and helping individuals complete an application for coverage through the New Health Insurance Marketplace created through the Affordable Care Act.

"We have a great opportunity to offer assistance to residents in the Pee Dee and South Carolina with obtaining health insurance through the Marketplace.
