

As transportation services continue to grow the need is being seen more and more region wide. CareFIRST Carolina is still looking for partners to grow needed essential services transportation routes in Dillon, Marion and Chesterfield counties. Many local governments as well as community minded businesses and industries are now coming together to create a better and safer way for local residents to get to and from work. pharmacies, medical/ dental appointments, shopping, paying bills as well as social services and trade school classes.

In Marlboro County alone nearly 3000 trips were taken in December of 2019! Services to the Wallace area are set to begin in February. Services in Dillon and





Marion are anticipated in April and mid-May, respectively. Local partners are making this happen.

Your gift could assist a young uninsured mother who may need a mammogram, a father who passed out at work due to undiagnosed diabetes and needs insulin but is not able to afford the medication, or even a relative who has an x-ray show a "shadow" that could be cancer but has no way to know for sure. We want to assist them, but need your support to do that! Community Health Centers do not have line item funding for these services and that is why the foundation was created.
